**Subject: Cattle trespass at southeastern ranch boundary**

On January 12, 2012 the Water Resources/ Range field technician and I spoke with Dan Genazzi on the Genazzi Ranch Reservation of Use and Occupancy (RUO). I told Dan we had noticed a few Genazzi cattle slipping through loose barbed wire into a seasonal exclusion area on Gallagher Ranch. Dan said that he was aware of the problem, and that it was a few individual animals that were repeatedly crossing the fence line. I asked if he would repair the fence as this area was not within his lease boundary, and that cattle should be excluded from the area in winter months. (b) (5)

**Subject: Cow count**

**02/08/2012**

On February 7, 2012 both the Water Resources/Range field technician and I independently counted a minimum of 90 cattle on the Genazzi Reservation of Use and Occupancy (RUO). We each conducted an independent count from a single location on a hillside on the west end of the RUO. In our counts we attempted to exclude calves that appeared to be under one year old, however it is possible that some of the animals were under the 1,000 pound standard measure of an Animal Unit (AU). The Genazzi reservation stipulates an annual stocking rate of 55 AUs, not to exceed 85 AUs at any one time.
